A History of Churches:

The Survival of New Testament Christianity Against Overwhelming Odds

Many of you know that for several years I have been working on a church history book. The project is nearing reality. The editing process should be complete by Thanksgiving. Shortly thereafter the book will be available as an eBook.

The Survival of New Testament Christianity Against Overwhelming Odds proves that Christians and churches which embraced the basic positions of New Testament Christianity have continuously existed from Jesus' church in Jerusalem, Israel to the present.

Evidence substantiates the fact that a people exists who were never part of Constantine's state church which ultimately became the Catholic Church. Over the centuries and in many locations they were known by different names; but they were here, wed together by their common commitment to the brand of Christianity taught in the New Testament. This book shows who they were, where they lived, what they believed and unbelievable efforts to eradicate them.

As these remarkable people are traced through the centuries, the circumstances of their survival come into focus. The

book deals with the Roman Empire, the tremendous persecutions these Christians faced at the hands of Pagan Rome, the formation of a state church and its ramifications, the breakdown of the old Roman Empire and the emergence of a new Europe, how Roman Catholic and an Eastern Orthodox Catholic Churches came into existence, the birth and spread of Islam, the Crusades, the Protestant Reformation and the proliferation of denominations. The book also shows why the New Testament has 27 books and not more or different books. One chapter is devoted to how the Bible made it into the English language and to the amazing King James Bible.

The book will be available through Amazon in both paper & eBook formats. The book consists of 31 chapters. It is well documented with hundreds of endnotes & a large bibliography. From Amazon the paper copies will be perfect bound. I will let you know as soon as they are available on Amazon.

Some of you have expressed a strong desire to have this book in comb

bound format. Paper books through Amazon will be black & white. I will be printing limited comb bound copies through Office Depot. The 60 pages of charts plus 10 pages of maps will be in color. Whereas we expect the Amazon books to be priced in the \$15.00 range (it is too soon to announce an exact price), these comb bind copies with color pages will be closer to \$50.00. Written materials
